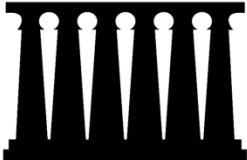

COUNTY ANNOUNCES LANE CLOSURES ON CRESTWOOD BOULEVARD AND NEW DESIGN ROAD

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Department of Highways and Transportation announced today that there will be temporary lane closures on Crestwood Boulevard between Burning Bush Drive and east of New Design Road; on New Design Road between the I-270 overpass and Crestwood Boulevard, and on Foxcroft Drive between Burning Bush Drive and New Design Road. The closures will start on or about September 21.

The work will occur between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, weather permitting. This will allow the contractor, C. J. Miller, LLC, to complete the construction of new left turn lanes and the lengthening of existing left turn lanes at these intersections.

The project will last for approximately 60 working days. Work zone signage and flagmen will be utilized to direct traffic through the construction areas. Department staff has notified emergency personnel.
